
## Christ was Forsaken by God So that we can Call Today Good Friday

Matthew 27:45-46; 50 (ESV) 45 Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land until the ninth hour. 46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

<sup>50</sup> And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice and yielded up his spirit.

**Psalm 22:6-8; 14-18 (NIV2011)** but I am a worm and not a man, scorned by everyone, despised by the people. <sup>7</sup> All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads. 8 "He trusts in the LORD," they say, "let the LORD rescue him. Let him deliver him, since he delights in him." <sup>14</sup>I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint. My heart has turned to wax; it has melted within me.  $^{15}$  My mouth is dried up like a potsherd, and my tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth; you lay me in the dust of death. 16 Dogs surround me, a pack of villains encircles me; they pierce my hands and my feet. 17 All my bones are on display; people stare and gloat over me.  $^{18}$  They divide my clothes among them and cast lots for my garment.
