Review of the First Advent's Waiting

Sin and the curse enter the world and the Messiah, who would strike the serpent, is first prophesied

The Prophet would be like Moses. Some began looking for 2 people (a Messiah and a Prophet).

Jesus became the sole mediator between God and man is the only way to the Father.

Now the congregation would hear from mediators instead of God's direct voice.

Look at the rest of the Old Testament and how they refer to kings as the "son of David" pointing to the Son of God.

David wrote Psalm 110 which predicted Jesus' eternal kingdom and eternal priesthood.

First, the imperfect son, Solomon, and many future kings would reign until the scepter came to Him to whom it belonged.
