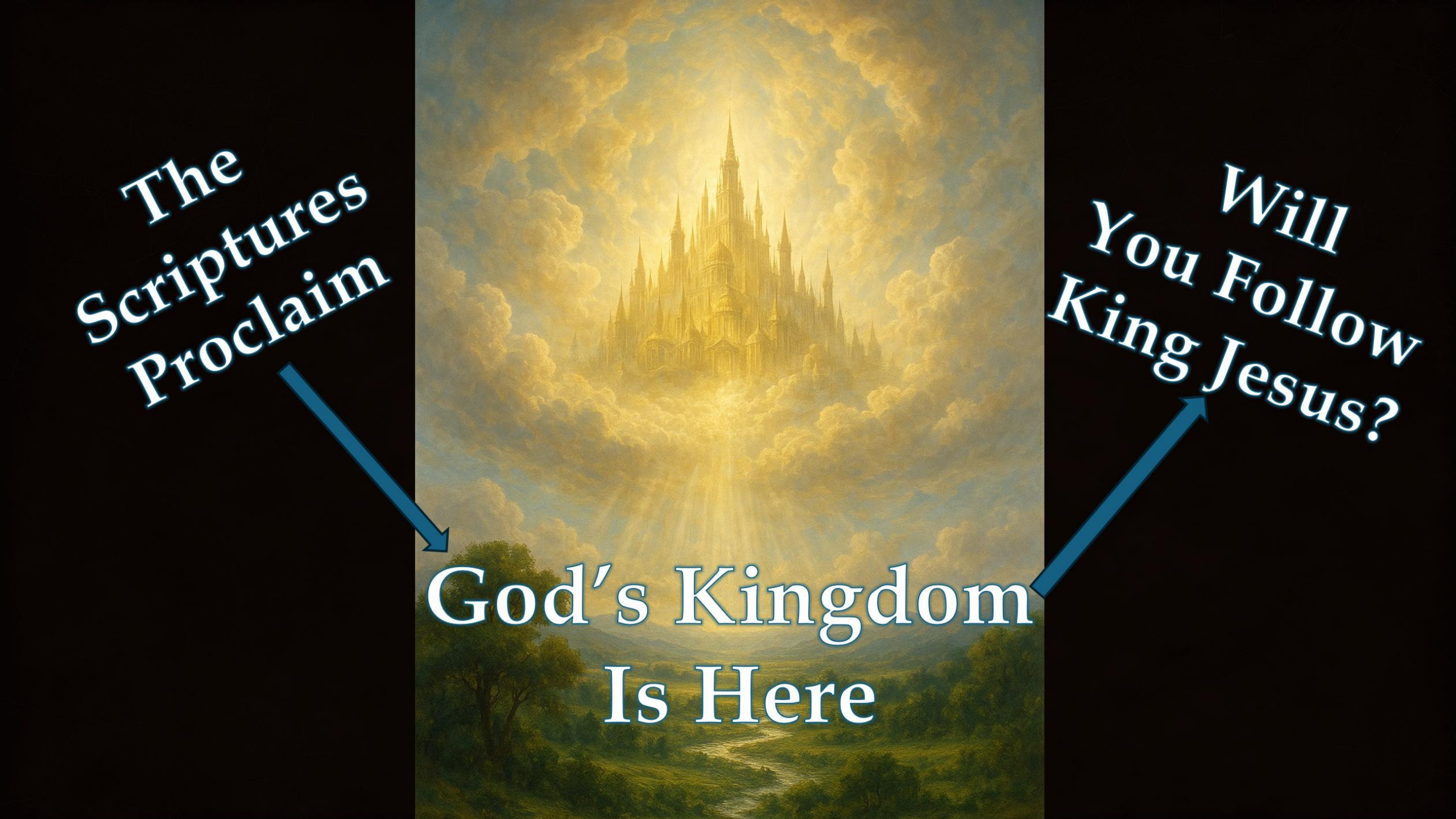

The Gospel of the Kingdom of God – Part 6

King Jesus and His Kingdom

Judah's & David's lines & the time for God's Kingdom were prophesied.

Satan inspired Herod to kill the young King, but the plan was thwarted.

John the Baptist first preached repentance & the Kingdom of God.
Then Jesus preached repentance & the Gospel of the Kingdom of God.

Kingdom blessings were preached for the poor & the persecuted. Jesus called for kingdom prayer, forgiving others, & obedience to the King.

Jesus is stronger than the enemy & He grants His authority to believers.
Slaves of the greatest Master (Jesus) are called to produce good fruit.

It was prophesied the perfect servant would die for our sin. The King died for all, so all who follow Him will have power over sin & death.

Shadows/ Signs of resurrection from the O.T.

Job 19:25-26 (LSB) ²⁵ As for me, I know that my Redeemer lives,
And at the last He will rise up over the dust *of this world*. ²⁶ Even after
my skin is destroyed, yet from my flesh I shall behold God,

Psalms 49:15 (NIV) But God will redeem me from the realm of the
dead; he will surely take me to himself.

Psalms 16:10 (CSB) For you will not abandon me to Sheol; you will
not allow your faithful one to see decay.

Isaiah 26:19 (NASB₁₉₉₅) Your dead will live; Their corpses will rise.
You who lie in the dust, awake and shout for joy, For your dew *is as* the
dew of the dawn, And the earth will give birth to the departed spirits.

Daniel 12:2 (ESV) And many of those who sleep in the dust of the
earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and
everlasting contempt.

1 Corinthians 15:16-26 (NKJV) ¹⁶ For if *the* dead do not rise, then Christ is not risen. ¹⁷ And if Christ is not risen, your faith *is* futile; you are still in your sins! ¹⁸ Then also those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. ¹⁹ If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men the most pitiable. ²⁰ But now Christ is risen from the dead, *and* has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. ²¹ For since by man *came* death, by Man also *came* the resurrection of the dead. ²² For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. ²³ But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those *who are* Christ's at His coming. ²⁴ Then *comes* the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. ²⁵ For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet. ²⁶ The last enemy *that* will be destroyed *is* death.

What evidence, inside and outside of scripture, should guide us toward believing in Jesus' resurrection?

- ☐ Jesus and His Kingdom's timeline were prophesied with perfection.
- ☐ Women were the first to see Jesus resurrected and they brought the news to the disciples.
- ☐ How ignorant and unbelieving did the disciples act before and after the resurrection.
- ☐ Would you die for something you knew was a lie?
- ☐ Saul of Tarsus/ the apostle Paul's life and death.
- ☐ Consider everyone who has ever lived and honestly ask yourself this question: What person has changed the world more than any other?

Did you know even Jesus' Ascension was prophesied?

Acts 1:8-9 (NIV)⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."⁹ After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight.

Daniel 7:13-14 (LSB)¹³ I kept looking in the night visions, And behold, with the clouds of heaven One like a Son of Man was coming, And He came up to the Ancient of Days and came near before Him.¹⁴ And to Him was given dominion, glory, and a kingdom, that all the peoples, nations, and *men of every* tongue might serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion which will not be taken away; and His kingdom is one which will not be destroyed.

King Jesus is on His throne. Will you daily choose to serve Him?
