## Daniel 2:21

He changes the times and the seasons. He removes kings and sets up kings. He gives wisdom to the wise, and knowledge to those who have understanding.

## Do you believe in miracles?

*If you were told something incredible was going to happen in the future, and it happened just like they described, wouldn't that be a miracle? Read on and learn how a man named Daniel, who lived long ago, was clearly told the future by God.*

*Daniel wrote about a dream that the king of Babylon had. It was about an image of 4 kingdoms (also known as empires), each represented by a certain type of metal (gold, silver, bronze, and iron mixed with clay).*



*Daniel wrote about the future of 3 of these kingdoms long before they even happened! If we look at history, we can learn that the 4th kingdom was ancient Rome.*

*The dream Daniel wrote about foretold that there was another kingdom, more powerful than the other 4. He wrote that God's Kingdom (pictured as a rock) would be different and would begin during the time of the Roman kingdom. It would start small, but then spread out across the world.*

*Later in Daniel's book, he foretold about the King of God's Kingdom. He wrote about a time when the King would be killed.*

*He wrote about the very time this King would be killed, long before it ever happened! God's Kingdom was described as very different. The King's focus would be to seek and save people instead of other kingdoms, which were seeking and destroying people.*

*Do you know that Jesus, the Christ (from where we get the word "Christmas"), announced the Kingdom of God had arrived at the very time Daniel said would happen (during the Roman kingdom!).*

*Jesus talked about His kingdom for only 3 ½ years and only told people who lived in a very small part of the world known as Israel. Back then, there were no phones, TVs, or computers to share the news, but today, people all over the world call Jesus their King! Why? Because they know that even though Jesus died, He rose from the dead, and is now alive forever!*

*Think of this: During Jesus' time on the earth, around 40 million people worshipped the fake gods of Rome and Greece. Now there are only a few thousand who worship those fake gods. When Jesus rose from the dead, there were only 120 people who followed Him. Now, the people who follow Jesus have grown to be a large part of the entire world! Isn't that miraculous? And, Daniel wrote about it long before it happened!*

*If that's not enough to believe in miracles, think of this: Imagine the meanest person you've ever known or read about. Now imagine, suddenly, they became the nicest person you could ever meet.*

*That's what happened to a man named Saul who changed His name to Paul. He first put those who followed Jesus into prison and called for them to be killed. Then, suddenly, after seeing Jesus alive, he started telling everyone that Jesus is the one true King who rose from the dead! He also told the people that it was Jesus who loves them the most and created them! Did you know that people hit Paul, threw rocks at him, and put him in prison? Paul still kept telling everyone that Jesus loved them and died for them. He told them that Jesus is now alive forever and is the King of the world.*

*So, then if King Jesus is the one who created you and the one who loves you more than anyone else, what should you do?*

*God created this world for us to live in peace with Him. But ever since the beginning, people have disobeyed God. You probably know it's wrong to hurt others, lie, and steal, but did you know it's wrong to even think bad thoughts about others?*

*It's not enough to be sorry for the things you've done wrong. You need God to save and forgive you. Since you have not been living your life to honor King Jesus, you need to ask for forgiveness and also forgive everyone who has done bad things to you. God, who loves you so much, came to earth as a man, named Jesus, and gave His life for you so that you could be forgiven and become part of His kingdom, His big family. Jesus rose from the dead and is now alive forever!*

*If you reject Jesus as King, you are headed for eternal destruction. If you choose to believe and follow Jesus as King and Savior, then you'll be completely forgiven and get to live forever with Him and His family. What will you do?*
